

How do I link an account to my login account?

You can **link** accounts that use your Login email (such as other family members) by searching for other records to Link. This way, you can have a single Login email, and view all family details.

- 1. Go to Link or unlink records via your name dropdown in the header




Linked Participants

You can **link** accounts that use your Login email (such as other family members) by searching for other records to Link.

You can **unlink** accounts that are no longer required to be linked (such as children who have their own email address) by selecting Unlink on a linked account.

- 3. Click on the **Search for other records to Link** button, and select other records matching your Login email, then select Link selected Records to link these to your account.
